Neighbourhood Watch is one of the biggest and most successful crime prevention Initiatives ever. Now involving more than 180,000 households in Hertfordshire, it is based on the simple idea that good neighbours can help to reduce crime and create a safer and better place to live, work and play.

By being a good neighbour, you can help make our community more secure by looking out for each other; keeping an eye on our homes when we are out; watching out for those who are elderly or vulnerable; and receiving and sharing crime prevention advice to help keep us all safe and our homes and property secure.

As a Neighbourhood Watch member, you will receive regular policing updates and alerts from our local policing team via email, or by telephone if preferred.

Your local policing team will keep you informed about what is happening locally and how you can help, for example to look out for stolen property, suspicious activity or help finding missing people. They will also tell you about local policing events; update you about crimes, incidents or concerning trends in your area; alert you to appeals for information; and keep you up-to-date with the latest crime prevention advice to share with your friends and neighbours to help you to keep yourselves and your property safe.

Also joining the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme is free and some insurance companies offer reductions on house insurance if you are a member.
