

Hertfordshire is set for Local Government Reorganisation, a once in a generation change that will shape how local services are delivered.

Councils across the county are working together to create proposals that protect what works, improve what doesn't and ensure services are joined up and closer to the communities they serve.

Local Government Reorganisation will move Hertfordshire from the current two-tier system, where residents have a local and county council, to a single tier of local government. The aim is to make services simpler and more accountable, while ensuring decisions remain connected to Hertfordshire's communities.
